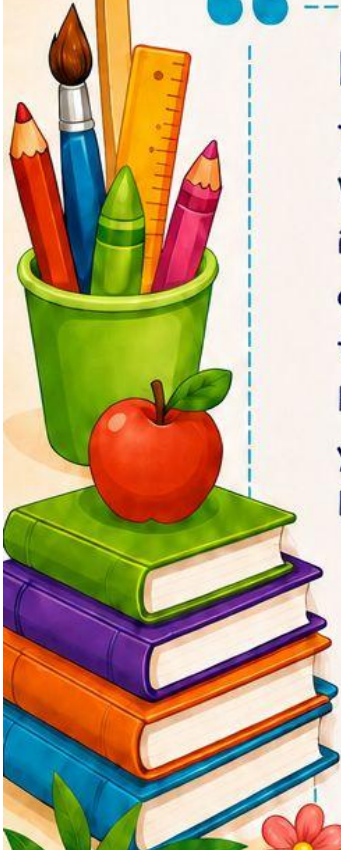
SUMMER HOLIDAY HOMEWORK
